Bikar welcomed eight new apprentices in Raumland

A total of 35 young people start their careers at Bikar



Raumland. Bikar welcomed eight new trainees on August 1, including six industrial clerks, one warehouse logistics specialist and one wholesale and export clerk.

On the occasion of the first training day, which was celebrated with get-to-know-you rounds, a company scavenger hunt through all company divisions and a joint lunch, Managing Director Pascal Bikar welcomed the new employees: "We are proud that you have placed your trust in us and want to start your professional career with us. In the past years, many of your predecessors were able to take over leading positions in our company and we look forward to developing more personalities with you in the years to come."

As part of the company scavenger hunt, the eight career starters also marveled at the construction site on the company's premises, which is intended to secure the

company's long-term future. In recent days, construction has begun on the impressive 25-meter-high high-bay warehouse. In a few months, rods, tubes and profiles made of aluminum, copper, brass and bronze will be stored here and prepared for shipment. In addition, six former apprentices who have recently completed their training will start their individual further training and university studies sponsored by Bikar in the next few weeks.

Bikar employs a total of over 490 people at its sites in Raumland and Korbußen in Thuringia. In July and August alone, 45 new employees were hired, including a total of 16 new apprentices. This means that 35 young people are currently completing their vocational training at the non-ferrous metal trader.
