Training manager Ingo Miß was himself once a trainee at the company: "What sets us apart is that we involve the young people in the actual processes from day one. As a result, they recognize the importance of their tasks at an early stage." Many employees at Bikar are committed to the topic of training and actively support it. In addition to school lessons, for example, there are also internal factory lessons. The special support bears fruit - the company has already produced the best apprentices in the chamber district five times in the past.

This year, at least six commercial and two industrial apprentices will start at the company. There are plans to increase the number of trainees in the industrial-technical area in particular, but there is a lack of applications. Tomczak confirms these developments: "The number of seekers has dropped significantly this year, which is also related to the current uncertainties." At Bikar, however, she is not worried: "Growth and employee development go hand in hand here. In addition, trainees are offered development opportunities and a future within the company. This makes Bikar a role model and it absolutely deserves this award," says Tomczak, summing up her impressions.
